

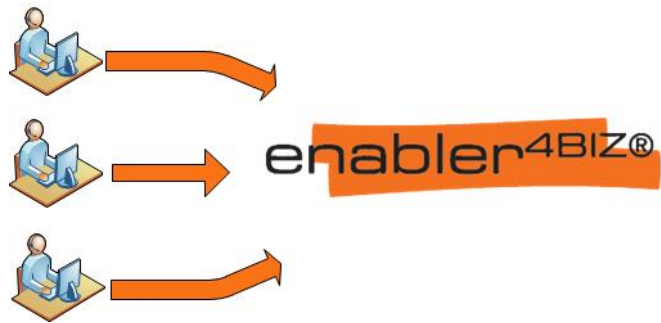
## Single Sign-On

The module Single Sign-On of the enabler<sup>4</sup>BIZ (abbreviated as SSO) enables the users to automatically log into the enabler<sup>4</sup>BIZ Management System without entering user name or password. For this purpose, the enabler<sup>4</sup>BIZ is connected to the Microsoft Active Directory (abbreviated as AD) and the user data synchronized automatically with the enabler<sup>4</sup>BIZ. When opening the enabler<sup>4</sup>BIZ, the windows login is automatically taken over.

This module therefore means reduced workload for the enabler<sup>4</sup>BIZ administration and for the users.

### Automatic user transfer from the Active Directory

- ▶ The synchronization takes place automatically every 24 hours
- ▶ This means that users that were created in the Active Directory today will automatically be created in the enabler<sup>4</sup>BIZ on the next day
- ▶ Manual synchronization is possible at any time via the enabler<sup>4</sup>BIZ administration
- ▶ No transfer of the Active Directory password. Only the first name, last name, user name and e-mail address are taken over
- ▶ The maintenance of the role assignment can either take place via the enabler<sup>4</sup>BIZ administration as usual or via groups in the Active Directory
- ▶ Users that are deleted from the Active Directory are automatically archived in the enabler<sup>4</sup>BIZ
- ▶ Users that are not available in the Active Directory can still be maintained in the enabler<sup>4</sup>BIZ. These can login manually as usual
- ▶ Daily automatic e-mail notifications to the administrator regarding newly imported or changed users



### Easy login

- ▶ The automatic login takes place directly when opening the enabler<sup>4</sup>BIZ. User name and password entry is not necessary anymore; the user is immediately registered with his Windows login data in the system.
- ▶ Best possible workload reduction in daily use, e.g. no login when using links to the enabler<sup>4</sup>BIZ in e-mail notifications
- ▶ The normal login with user name and password is still possible independent of this – e.g. when using the enabler<sup>4</sup>BIZ **via the internet**
- ▶ Password maintenance not necessary anymore
- ▶ No threat of forgotten passwords

### enabler<sup>4</sup>BIZ Single Sign-On

- ▶ Automatic user transfer from the Active Directory – therefore, entering user name and password is not required anymore
